# SELECTION CRITERIA for 2015 FINA WORLD AQUATIC CHAMPIONSHIPS, OPEN WATER SWIMMING

## Kazan, Russia 25 JULY – 1 AUGUST 2015

## 1) Eligibility

- 1.1 Only athletes registered with and in good standing with SSA will be considered for selection.
- 1.2 Selected athletes must be in possession of a South African passport, valid until March 2016 and have chosen South Africa as their Sport Nationality.
- 1.3 Swimmers under the age of 18years must be in possession of an Unabridged Birth Certificate.
- 1.4 Members selected to the team must abide by the SSA Code of Conduct as appended to the SSA Constitution and agree to and sign the SSA Athlete / Official Agreement for the 16<sup>th</sup> FINA World Aquatic Championships 2015.
- 1.5 Athletes must be available to travel to and compete at the 16<sup>th</sup> FINA World Championships 2015 in Kazan, Russia, from 22 July 2 August 2015.
- 1.6 To be eligible for selection swimmers must have participated at the 2015 SA National Open Water Championships (Official South African 2015 16<sup>th</sup> FINA World Championships Open Water Swimming Trials) that took place in Elgin, 7 and 8 March 2015.
- 1.7 All athletes selected, must be available for the 5km Team Event if selected.
- 1.8 All athletes must be available for the full duration of the pre 2015
   16<sup>th</sup> FINA World Championships camp. Dates and venues to be confirmed.



- 1.9 Team selection will be in accordance with the SSA Transformation Policy in relation to demographic and gender equity where applicable.
- 1.10 The SSA Executive reserves the right to amend these criteria and circulate such amended criteria.
- 1.11 The final team selection is subject to approval by the SSA Executive Committee

## 2) Criteria

2.1 Team Size: As per FINA Rules, maximum of 2 swimmers per event

#### 2.2 Events

- 2.2.1 Individual Events: (Male and Female)
  - 2.2.1.1 5km
  - 2.2.1.2 10km
  - 2.2.1.3 25km

#### 2.2.2 5km Team event: Mixed

- 2.2.2.1 Three swimmers must be selected for the team event
- 2.2.2.2 Either two males and one female or
- 2.2.2.3 One male ad two females
- 2.3 The times achieved by swimmers at the SA National Open Water Swimming Championships may be considered for selection.



- 2.4The first and second placed athletes in the 5km and 10km individual event at the 2015 South African National Open Water Championships, may be considered for selection.
- 2.5 Swimmers who would like to be considered for the 25km event must have verified times for this event and have placed in the top 5 in the 10km events as S A National OWS Championships. All costs related to competing in this event will be the responsibility of the selected swimmer.
- 2.6 Selection for all events will be dependent on the athlete's performances at the trials being internationally competitive.
- 2.7SSA reserves the right to approve or hold additional qualifying competitions (due to inclement weather etc.) if they feel it is in the interests of South African Open Water Swimming.

## 3 Funding

- 3.1 This will be a partially subsidized tour.
- 3.2 Team members will be partially subsidized according to their level of performance.
