

AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BETWEEN THE SOUTH AFRICAN SPORTS CONFEDERATION AND OLYMPIC COMMITTEE (SASCOC)

AND

SWIMMING SOUTH AFRICA (SSA) ON THE SELECTION OF ATHLETES FOR THE

GABORONE 2014 AFRICAN YOUTH GAMES
22 TO 31 MAY 2014

1. ELIGIBILITY OF ATHLETES

For the athlete to be eligible for selection for Games delivered by SASCOC, the athlete shall satisfy the following General Eligibility Criteria:

- 1.1 Be a South African Citizen with a valid RSA passport;
- 1.2 Be a member in good standing with the National Federation (NF) affiliated to and in good standing with SASCOC;
- 1.3 Not be under suspension for any offence (including but not limited to doping) during the selection and Games period (01 April 2013 to 31 May 2014);
- 1.4 Not competed for another country within a three year period prior to being considered for selection for international multi-coded events delivered by SASCOC:
- 1.5 Comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force;
- 1.6 Comply with and uphold SASCOC's Articles of Association, Rules and Regulations of their respective NF, their African Confederation and ANOCA;
- 1.7 Have competed at the NF's National Championships in 2013.

2. SPORT SPECIFIC SELECTION CRITERIA

Over and above the General Eligibility Criteria, SASCOC and SSA agree on the following sport specific selection criteria for selection of athletes:

Athletes shall:

- 2.1 Be born between **01 January 1996 31 December1999**;
- 2.2 Be ranked in the Top 5 in the continent in their respective event during **01 April 2013 to 28 February 2014**;
- 2.3 The deadline for final selection shall be **14 March 2014.**

3. REPLACEMENTS

Date:

In an event that selected athletes have to be replaced due to injury, the Rules and Regulations of the Continental Confederation shall be applicable. The replacement athlete however, shall be part of the NF's African Youth Games long list submitted to SASCOC.
