

**SELECTION CRITERIA, 4<sup>th</sup> FINA WORLD MEN'S WATER POLO DEVELOPMENT TROPHY****KUWAIT, 4 – 12 MAY 2013****1. Eligibility**

- 1.1. Only athletes registered with and in good standing with SSA will be considered for selection.
- 1.2. Selected athletes must be in possession of a valid South African passport and have chosen South Africa as their Sport Nationality.
- 1.3. Members selected to the team must abide by the SSA Code of Conduct as appended to the SSA Constitution and agree to and sign the SSA Athlete / Official Agreement for 4th FINA World Men's Water Polo Development Trophy 2013.
- 1.4. To be eligible for selection an athlete must participate at the SSA National Water Polo Championships (Official South African 2013 Water Polo Trials) that will take place in Port Elizabeth from 10 to 13 April 2013.
- 1.5. Athletes must be available to travel to and compete at the 4th FINA World Men's Water Polo Development Trophy 2013 in Kuwait, 4 – 12 May 2013.
- 1.6. All athletes must be available for the full duration of the pre 4<sup>th</sup> FINA World Men's Water Polo Development Trophy 2013 camp, which is tentatively scheduled for end April 2013 (exact dates and venues to be confirmed once logistical arrangements have been finalized).
- 1.7. Team selection will be in accordance with the SSA Transformation Policy in relation to demographic equity where applicable.
- 1.8. Only athletes who have not represented South Africa at any level – Senior, Junior or Youth will be considered.
- 1.9. Consideration will be given to registered developmental level athletes not at SA Nationals, in regard to points 1.7 and 1.8 to comply with the FINA requirements for the appropriate level team.
- 1.10. The SSA Executive Committee reserves the right to amend these criteria and circulate such amended criteria.
- 1.11. The final team selection is subject to approval by the SSA Executive Committee.

**2. Funding**

- 2.1. This tour will be partially subsidized.



### 3. **Criteria**

- 3.1. The selected squad will be required to attend all the training camps.
- 3.2. Should a position in the team become available due to the injury or withdrawal of an athlete, after the team announcement, the Water Polo Selection Committee may consider an athlete from the selected squad on the basis of their overall commitment and attendance at the training camps.

#### 3.3. **Conditions of Selection**

- 3.3.1. Each team member must attend the training camp after the final team has been selected.
- 3.3.2. Pass fitness/flexibility tests at training camp.
- 3.3.3. Athletes may be cut from the group if the weekly fitness test results are not satisfactory, and after training camps if progress or attitude is not up to standard. This is at the discretion of SSA after submission from the coach.
- 3.3.4. The selectors, will make the final selection of athletes to compete as follows:
  - 3.3.4.1. Work Ethic
  - 3.3.4.2. Physical competitive readiness and physical suitability
- 3.3.5. Athlete performance at SA Nationals will be taken into account. Athletes not participating at SA Nationals will not be eligible.

### 4. **Tests**

- 4.1. For athletes to be considered for selection for the final team, they need to ensure that they complete swimming tests on a weekly basis and submit a record of same to SSA and the Team Coach.
- 4.2. A further two tests consisting of any of tests one to five will be conducted by the coach at the camp. Tests one to five is attached hereto as Annexure A.
- 4.3. Test one will start the sequence of the tests as determined by the National Head Coach, thereafter followed by tests two, three, four and five.
- 4.4. Should a athlete for any reason not submit a swim test as per the defined submission date, a "Did Not Submit (DNS) will be recorded;
- 4.5. Test results must be submitted in the attached excel format only.

### 5 **Training Camps**

Attendance at the Training Camp will be Compulsory for Squad and Team Members
