SELECTION CRITERIA, FINA Water Polo World League Inter-Continental Cup 2019,

Perth (AUS) 25-31 March 2019. (Men and Women)

1. <u>Eligibility</u>

- 1.1. Only athletes registered with and in good standing with SSA will be considered for selection.
- 1.2. Selected athletes must be in possession of a valid South African passport until October 2019 and have chosen South Africa as their Sporting Nationality.
- 1.3. Players u/18 must be in possession of an unabridged birth certificate
- 1.4. Members selected to the team must abide by the SSA Code of Conduct as appended to the SSA Constitution and agree to and sign the SSA Athlete / Official Agreement for the FINA Water Polo World League Inter-Continental Cup 2019, Perth (AUS)
- 1.5. To be eligible for selection an athlete must have attended and participated at the National Training/Selection Camp to be held in Durban (Men) and Cape Town (Women), in January 2019. Athletes will have to pass a fitness tests at the Camp. Injury or Ill Health will not serve as justification for not passing the tests.
- 1.6. Athletes must participate at the SSA National Water Polo Championship in Gauteng In March 2019.
- 1.7. Athletes must be available to travel to and compete at the FINA Water Polo World League Inter-Continental Cup 2019, held in Perth (AUS) from the 25-31 March 2019.
- 1.8. Team selection will be in accordance with the SSA Transformation Policy in relation to demographic and gender equity where applicable.
- 1.9. The SSA Executive Committee reserves the right to amend these criteria and circulate such amended criteria.
- 1.10. The final team selection is subject to approval by the SSA Executive Committee.

2. <u>Funding</u>

2.1. This tour will be self-funded.

3. <u>Criteria</u>

3.1. The selected team will be required to attend all the training camps as directed by the Head Coach.

3.2. Should a position in the team become available due to the injury or withdrawal of an athlete, after the team announcement, the Water Polo Selection Committee may consider an athlete from the selected team reserves on the basis of their overall performance, commitment and attendance at the training camps.

3.3. <u>Conditions of Selection</u>

- 3.3.1. Each team member must attend all training camps and training program as directed by the Head Coach.
- 3.3.2. Pass fitness/flexibility tests.
- 3.3.3. Submit swim tests as required by the Coach.
- 3.3.4. Athletes may be cut from the team if the weekly fitness test results are not satisfactory, and after training camps, if progress or attitude is not up to standard. This is at the discretion of SSA after submission from the coach.
